

Safeguarding at Newton's Walk

Safeguarding means preventing harm to children's health or development, protecting children from abuse and maltreatment, ensuring children grow up with safe and effective care and taking action to enable all children to have the best outcomes.

We want everyone to feel safe and happy at Newton's Walk. Children can talk to the adults in school if anything is worrying them, if they feel unsafe or if they need help with anything.

How will I get to school and home again?

Children usually come to Newton's walk in a taxi. A taxi will pick me up from home. I will sit in the back of the taxi.

I might have a booster seat. I will wear a seat belt.



An adult will walk me to the gate and wait with me until someone lets me in.



When school finishes an adult will let me know when my taxi is here. A taxi will take me home.

What is the uniform at Newton's Walk?

Children are also allowed to wear the uniform from
their old school instead.

School starts at 9.30am Monday to Friday.



Children spend the morning learning in their classroom, then go for lunch in the hall at 12.00pm.



Some children have hot dinners or sandwiches from school and some children bring their own packed lunch from home.

After lunch, children go back to their classroom to enjoy some SHINE activities and more learning.

School finishes at 2.30pm



When children first start at Newton's Walk, they have their own timetable and only come to school for a short time each day to help them to settle in.

Classes at Newton's Walk are quite small and each class has a Teacher and two Teaching Assistants to support children and help them to learn.

Each class has children from different year groups, so there might be older and younger children working on different tasks in one classroom.

Everyone is expected to follow our school's three rules:

- 1. That children should be **Ready** to learn.
- 2. That children show **Respect** for everyone and everything.
- 3. That children stay **Safe** by being in the right place at the right time.

Adults who see children showing the **Ready**, **Respect**, **Safe** positive behaviours can award them coloured points, which add up to earn badges and wristbands.

During every part of the school day, children can earn voucher points and shop points by showing positive behaviour.

Each day, children get a new achievement sheet to take home, which shows their targets and the points that they have earned.

When children first start, on their own shorter timetable, they can only earn points for sessions they are in school for. Once their timetable is increased to full time, children can earn up to 42 voucher points every day! Once they reach 800 points, children receive a £10 gift voucher for a shop of their choice.

At the end of the week, all of the shop points are added up and children get "wages" to spend in the rewards shop. There are some things which only cost a few points, or children can save their points up to buy bigger items.



Extra points are given out every half term to children who have good attendance.
